

## MAGICAID RESEARCH


Patients seen

This research focuses on how MagicAid magic therapy reduces pain and anxiety in children undergoing invasive procedures in the Emergency Department. Early results are encouraging — therapy sessions eased anxiety and were praised by staff and families for easing stress during challenging moments. A big thank you to our medical student leaders for spearheading this effort!
